
Copper Leaf Peel-off – Card Instructions



1) Leaves with Green Corners

- Tear a piece of cream card slightly larger than the three leaves peel-off.
- Sponge brown ink all over the card.
- Tear a slightly smaller piece of orange vellum and sponge with brown and black ink.
- Stick the vellum on the sponged panel.
- Use masking tape to pick up the pieces of the three large leaves and place on green vellum.
- Tear out each leaf and sponge with brown ink.
- Stick the leaves in a row on the vellum and card panel.
- Mount the panel on a cream card adding two pieces of green vellum as a part border.
- Add the word 'leaves' below the panel.
- Complete the card with dot and square accents.

2) Tall Card with Green Leaf

- Cut out a square embossed frame from spare card.
- Sponge the square with brown ink.
- Tear a small piece of green vellum and sponge over with brown ink.
- Stick the vellum inside the embossed frame.
- Use some masking tape to pick up the pieces of one small leaf.
- Place the pieces inside the embossed frame over the green vellum.
- Use a small leaf peel-off as a stencil to sponge a background on a cream card with brown ink.
- Stick a green square on the card slightly larger than the leaf panel.
- Mount the leaf panel on the green square with sticky fixers.
- Pick up the pieces of a larger leaf, adhere to green vellum and tear out.
- Sponge the leaf with brown ink and stick below the panel on the completed card.

3) Yellow Backed, Leaf Trio

- Punch out a large, yellow vellum square.
- Stick the square on a cream card.
- Tear three small pieces of orange vellum.
- Stick the orange pieces in a row across the large yellow square.
- Place a leaf peel-off on each orange square.
- Add the word 'leaves' below the yellow square and some squares and dots at random around the leaves.
- Complete the card with some glitter on the leaves.

4) Single Leaf Square Card

- Cut out a square embossed frame from spare card.
- Sponge the square with brown ink.
- Tear a small piece of orange vellum and sponge over with brown ink.
- Adhere the vellum piece inside the embossed frame.
- Place a leaf peel-off over the vellum.
- Mount the small square panel on a cream card with sticky fixers.
- Add dots and squares at random all over the front panel of the card.
- Complete the card with some glitter on the leaves and in some of the tiny open squares.

5) Leaf Trio on Deckle Edged Rectangle Panel with Inked Edges

- Tear a piece of orange vellum slightly larger than the three leaves peel-off.
- Sponge brown, copper and black ink on the vellum.
- Place the peel-off on the sponged vellum.
- Tear a slightly larger piece of cream card and sponge brown ink over the torn edges.
- Adhere the vellum on the sponged cream card.
- Mount the completed panel on a cream card.
- Add some squares to the panel and card.
- Complete the card with some glitter on the leaves.

6) Leaf Trio on Tall Cream Card

- Tear three pieces of orange vellum to fit inside the embossed frames on a tall cream card.
- Adhere the orange pieces in place.
- Place a leaf peel-off on each orange square.
- Add the word 'leaves' up the side of the card and some squares and dots at random around the embossed frames.
- Complete the card with some glitter on the leaves.

7) Leaf Trio with Negative Background

- Tear a piece of cream card slightly larger than the three leaves peel-off.
- Sponge brown ink all over the card.
- Tear three pieces of orange vellum. Sponge the pieces with brown and black ink.
- Stick the vellum pieces on the sponged cream card.
- Place the peel-off on the panel. Use a small leaf peel-off as a stencil to sponge a background on a cream card with brown ink.
- Mount the leaves panel on the folded card adding gems to complete.

8) Leaf Trio on Left Hand Side

- Cut out three square embossed frames from spare card.
- Tear three small pieces of orange vellum and partly sponge each one over with brown ink.
- Stick the vellum pieces inside the embossed frames.
- Use masking tape to pick up the pieces of the three small leaves.
- Place the pieces inside the three embossed frames over the orange vellum.
- Tear away half the front panel of a cream card.
- Sponge over the torn edge with brown ink.
- Tear a strip of orange vellum and sponge over with brown ink.
- Adhere the strip on the card.
- Mount the three squares in a column on the card over the edge of the orange strip.
- Add the word leaves up the side of the card and some squares on back panel.
